MYANMAR BETWEEN COVID AND THE COUP D'ETAT

Answer Myanmar, Alliance for Peace, launches new campaign; The Right to Health Campaign. The campaign focuses on the emergency situation in Myanmar with the people trapped between COVID and the military behind February's coup d'etat.

The aims of the campaign are to:

1. Influence governments and international organisations to pressure Myanmar's military to allow unhindered humanitarian access to all communities in Myanmar.
2. Influence governments, international organisations and businesses to provide humanitarian aid in the form of finance, medication, protective gear, ventilators, oxygen supply and vaccines etc., to the NUG and Ethnic Health Organisations to ensure their non-discriminate and unhindered distribution.
3. Mobilise businesses, organisations and individuals who are good and willing to respond to this crisis in whatever small or large capacity possible.
4. Raise awareness of the situation in Myanmar, and amplify the voices of the people internationally.

Now is the time for all able and willing to unite behind the people of Myanmar's call for urgent support as the deadly third wave kills thousands of lives in Myanmar, and the intentions of the military to not help the people have been made clear. Doctors and medical volunteers are being arrested, oxygen plants shut down, and medical facilities are being occupied and taken over by the same military authorities who have killed over 900 innocent civilians and who have arrested over 6800 since the crackdown following the 1st of February coup d'etat.

The campaign uses multiple mediums in the pursuit of these aims, providing different strategies for businesses, organisations and individuals to get involved.
